### Event & Order of Merit Format & Conditions

#### 1. Event Format

**Note 1:** This is a guide that can be adjusted depending of field size and handicap spread.

**Note 2:** All players under 19 Hcp must keep their stroke score to enable their round to be eligible for Victorian Junior Rankings

#### 2. Conditions

- All events will be played in accordance with the rules of golf and any local rules which may be in force at the course over which the event is being played.
- Competitors must be 17 or under on the day of the event.
- Competitors must play a minimum of 4 rounds to be eligible to win the Order of Merit

#### 3. Order of Merit Conditions

- Competitors must be a financial member of an affiliated WDGA Club to be eligible for the Junior Order of Merit.
- The Order of Merit will consist of a Gross & Nett Section.
- Adjusted Gross and Nett scores will be used for counting scores.
- Stableford scores will be converted to Stroke.
- Competitors best 4 adjusted Gross & Nett scores will be averaged to calculate scores in the respective sections.
- In the event of a tie for final finishing positions, a count-back based on;
  - The lowest single adjusted round for each tied competitor, then

- II. The respective players' scores in the WDGA Junior Championship, then
- III. The number of events played in during the year

g) The winner of the Order of Merit (Gross Section) will receive an invitation to the Junior Vic Open.

**Note:** Returned Gross and Nett scores will be adjusted to a Par 70 based on the DSR;  
Eg; Actual Score 75, DSR 72. To adjust the returned score to Par 70 the recorded Order of Merit score will be 73
